

ECO 495 – Undergraduate Supervised Teaching (UTA) Department Policy and Instructions

To be considered for a position as an ECO 495 UTA, you must satisfy the University and Department policy.

1. For ECO 181 or ECO 182, you must meet the requirements in *either* (a) or (b):

- (a) You must have taken *both* ECO 181 *and* ECO 182 (or their equivalents from other institutions), received at least an A- grade in the appropriate course for which you will assist, and have a GPA of 3.3 or higher overall and in Economics.
- (b) You must have received at least an A- in the appropriate upper-level course (ECO 405 Microeconomic Theory, or ECO 407 Macroeconomic Theory) and have a GPA of 3.3 or higher overall and in Economics.
- 2. For all other courses, you must meet the requirements in *both* (a) *and* (b):
 - (a) You must have received at least an A- grade in the course in which you will assist.
 - (b) You must have a GPA of 3.3 or higher overall and in Economics.
- 3. You must have at least 60 credit hours already completed.
- 4. You must have a recommendation letter from the supervising faculty member for whom you will serve as a UTA.
- 5. You must fill out the ECO 495 Application below and submit it to <u>ecomain@buffalo.edu</u> with the recommendation letter from the supervising faculty member and a current copy of your Academic Advisement Report.
- 6. To be considered, all paperwork must be received before the last day of each semester's Add/Drop period.

Note: For Economics BA degree students, a maximum of 3 credits from *either* ECO 495 *or* ECO 496 are allowed to count toward your any-level Economics elective requirements.

If your application is approved, you will be automatically force registered into ECO 495 for 3 credit hours and will see the update in your class schedule via your HUB student center. There is no need to fill out a separate force registration request form.
