### **Economics Honors Program:**

The Department of Economics would like to acknowledge excellent graduating seniors who have met the honors program requirements. These requirements are set to distinguish exceptional seniors among their peers and demonstrate a deeper understanding of Economics.

**BA:** We nominate students who completed (1) MTH 141, (2) MTH 142, (3) ECO 406, and (4) whose cumulative GPA in economics courses is at least 3.25.

**BS:** We nominate students who completed (1) MTH 141, (2) MTH 142, (3) ECO 498 or 499 with a recommendation letter, and (4) whose cumulative GPA in economics courses of at least 3.25.

For both BA and BS, if students' cumulative GPA in economics courses are at least 3.25, then they are nominated for Honors; if it is at least 3.50 they are nominated for High Honors; and if it is at least 3.75, they are nominated for Highest Honors.
