

UB Psi Chi Application

Psi Chi (pronounced “*sigh - ka*”) is the International Honor Society in Psychology.

- You are eligible to join UB’s Psi Chi Chapter if you meet the membership criteria (see below).
- Membership is a lifetime honor. Your membership is preserved at the Psi Chi International Office and can be included on graduate school and employment applications.
- When you are inducted into Psi Chi, you will be presented with a frameable membership certificate, and you will be eligible to purchase and wear Psi Chi emblems including pins, charms, cords, etc.

Membership Criteria

If you are a Psychology **Major**, you must have:

- 1) Current status as a Psychology Major
- 2) Completed the following psychology courses:
 - Introductory Psychology (PSY 101)
 - Psychological Statistics (PSY 207)
 - Scientific Inquiry (PSY 350)
- 3) A psychology GPA of 3.4 or better and a cumulative GPA of 3.1 or better

If you are a Psychology **Minor**, you must have:

- 1) Current status as a Psychology Minor
- 2) Completed 9 credits of the Psychology Minor
- 3) A psychology GPA of 3.4 or better and a cumulative GPA of 3.1 or better

Application Process

- Psi Chi inducts members twice each year, once in **fall** and once in **spring**
- To join, you must:
 - Meet **all** eligibility requirements
 - Complete the **TWO applications** listed below by the deadline.

Step 1: Submit the Psi Chi International Membership Application

- **Complete** your Psi Chi International application through the [Psi Chi International portal](#)
- **Before submitting**, be sure to select the **University at Buffalo, The State University of NY** chapter

Step 2: Submit the UB Psi Chi Chapter Application and Materials

- **Complete** the UB Psi Chi chapter application form (**see below**).
- **Submit** that completed form through [UB Marketplace](#), along with:
 - An **unofficial transcript** or **Academic Advisement Report**, including any previous institutions
 - A **short paragraph** describing what you hope UB’s Psi Chi chapter will accomplish
 - Payment of the **one-time \$75 membership fee**
 - If the membership fee is a financial barrier for you, there are limited (one per semester) Psi Chi membership assistance scholarships. Contact [Dr. Joyce Lacy](#) for additional information.
