DEPARTMENT OF ART 2020 RUMSEY SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION

Overview

The purpose of the Rumsey Scholarship is to provide funding for summer travel to students who wish to further develop their artistic practice. Approximately \$2,000 is awarded each year to a student Sophomore or higher who will be returning for the full 2020 – 21 academic school year. Applicants must participate in a competitive exhibition, from which the Department of Art faculty will select a scholarship winner based on the quality of both the exhibited sample work and the accompanying written travel proposal. Scholarship recipients are *required* to showcase the work resulting from their summer study in the 2021 follow-up Rumsey exhibition.

Eligibility

Applicant must be a sophomore or junior-level BA or BFA Art major with a department GPA of 2.5 or higher. Fourth-year students who have junior-standing in the Art program due to a change in majors are also considered eligible. Applicants must return for a two-semester junior or senior year. The Art Advisor will verify the eligibility of each applicant.

Travel Proposal

A detailed, typewritten proposal describing your summer travel plan must be submitted *prior* to the opening of the competitive exhibition. The proposal must be **signed by a faculty** mentor who supports your plan, and it should include:

- 1. The travel locale and itinerary
- 2. Purpose of study
- Description of how this experience will assist the development of your artwork and/or scholarship
- 4. Detailed estimate of travel costs and/or tuition

If the objective of the proposal is not fulfilled, the recipient will be required to return the award.

Notable Changes

This year students will be expected to hang their own works with the assistance of their

Faculty Mentor. So be sure you communicate with your mentor on all phases!

After all work is dropped off (01/29) the show will be curated for placement by UB Art Galleries and Mark Snyder. The students will then coordinate with the gallery & Faculty Mentor on times to hang their work by February 4, 2020.

Application Procedure

- Submission of Application: The Rumsey Scholarship application is due in 202 CFA, the Department of Art office, by Friday, December 6, 2019, 3PM. Applications will not be accepted after this date. Ineligible applicants will be notified via email. Appeals may be made in writing to the Department of Art Chair within one week of notice.
- Submission of artwork: All work for the competitive exhibition must be delivered to the UB Art Galleries, Second Floor, by Weds, January 29, 2020, 3PM at the latest, work submitted after this date will not be part of the exhibition. All works must have attached to the backside the artist's name, title, year, medium and dimensions, (H x W x D)
- 3. Submission of proposal: Digital copies of your proposal, submission of travel expense estimates, the name of your faculty mentor (be sure you have their approval first) and digital images of the submitted works are due by Thursday, January 31, 2020, 3PM. An email will be sent directing you on how to submit this information. Applicants who do not submit a proposal by this date will be disqualified from the competitive exhibition.
