COMMUNITY INTERNSHIP APPLICATION PSC496

To qualify for the Department of Political Science Community Internship Program you must complete all the following requirements:

- (1) The student is responsible for finding the internship. The internship must be related to Political Science. You should be able to identify coursework you have completed that is related to the internship.
- (2) Discuss and prepare a list of readings and a paper proposal with the faculty sponsor (who must be a political science faculty member who specializes in a field relevant to the internship) of the internship. You will be required to write a paper on a topic related to the internship. The grade you receive for the paper will be your grade for the internship. Please work directly with your faculty sponsor to determine the length and content of the paper.
- (3) You must submit a letter with this application from your internship agency that verifies the number of hours you will work and a general description of your internship duties.
- (4) PSC496 counts as 3 hours of tutorial credit. Please keep in mind that the Department has a tutorial limit of 6 credit hours, and the University has a tutorial credit limit of 18 credits.
- (5) Only current internships will be considered, no internship credit will be awarded retroactively.
- (6) All paperwork must be handed in to 520 Park Hall by the end of the first week of classes. Late or incomplete paperwork will not be accepted.
